STIRLING swimmer Damian Fyfe will take part in the biggest competition of his short swimming career in January next year when he heads to Sydney for the Australian Youth Olympic Festival.

The competition, which will see the top under-17 swimmers from nations such as Japan and Canada compete against each other, is generally seen as a strong pathway to Olympic selection,

At just 15, Fyfe, who swims for Perth City, believes Olympic selection may be quite a few years away.

"I started swimming at a young age but I've only been swimming competitively since I was about 10 or 11," he said.

"There were only two 15-year-olds selected for the team, so it was a
